



Applicant's Checklist

Eligibility Criteria

- O Be a Canadian citizen and First Nations, Inuit or Métis member
- O Have lived in Val-d'Or for at least 12 months over the last 24 months
- O Be independent or helped by a caregiver
- O Have an income equal to or less than:

Individual or couple	2–3 people (not a couple)	4–5 people	6 people
\$24,000	\$29,500	\$33,000	\$38,500

- Provide the required documents for all members of the household
- Fill out the "Affordable Housing Application" form in full
- O Be willing to sign and respect a Code of Living (when there is a rent attribution)

Required Documents

APPLICANT

- O Document proving you are a First Nations, Inuit or Metis member (status card, client identification number, Band Council letter, blue fuel tax exemption card)
- O Income tax report for the year preceding or the Notice of Assessment with the statements for all adult occupants (RL-5, T4, T4A, RL-2, RL-3, T5...)

IF YOU HAVE ADULT CHILDREN IN SCHOOL

O Proof of full-time student status

PROOF OF RESIDENCY LAST 24 MONTHS

O Copy of lease, signed rent payment receipts, electric, phone or cell phone bills, bank statements, government letters, driver's license, etc.

SINGLE-PARENT OR BLENDED FAMILY

Proof of % custody:

 Legal custody order for the child or children, copy of the mediation agreement or parental agreement

OR

 Annual income for child support purposes (indicates the name(s) of dependent children)

Proof of Alimony:

Alimony payments or absence of payments
